9	Office	e Sheriff's Office in an interview room at John Young and 50 with Can you
10	State	your name for me please sir?
11		
12	BR	Brett Douglas Reilly.
13	CE	And joining us in a minute will be Sergeant John Allen. Brett can you raise your
14		right hand for me? You swear everything you say today is going to be true
15	BR	l do.
16	CE	Okay. Um, Brett you're here today regarding your involvement in assisting
17		with ah, (Inaudible) Caylee Anthony, is that correct?
18	BR	Correct.
19	CE	Okay. Your name was brought to our attention from doing other interviews
20 21		that you may have assisted Texas EquuSearch. I think it was Brett Churchill that
22		originally brought your name to my attention. And then a ah, also Carolyn
23		Todd I think there was an issue with a check or something when you joined
24		Texas EquuSearch. So, your name has come up quite
25	BR	Yeah.

1	CE	several times. That's why we called you. Um, did did you in fact
2		search the area of Suburban during any of those ah, coordinated or
3		uncoordinated searches?
4	BR	Um, I did not get involved with the coordinated searches for TES. I was assigned
5		to other areas, but ah, in the absence of TES when they left both the first time
6		and the second time, yes. We went down into the Suburban area.
7	CE	Okay when you say we, who, who were you with?
8 9	BR	Richard Creque um, Cindy Brennan, ah, and some of the I guess at the time
10		I didn't realize it, but connected to the Gail St. John's ah, psychic group. Um,
11		basically I, I think they called them the SOS Team or something. But ah, Richard
12		and I kind of took 'em under our wings to try and get them if they were gonna
13		do searching, to do it with Texas EquuSearch standards. In other words you
14	1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 1	know have some type of command control and all of that.
15	CE	Did um, were you every down there with a Laurie Creque or a Brett Churchill or
16		any of that, that group?
17	BR	Um, Brett Churchill I do believe um, Laurie Creque, yeah, she was part of the
18		SOS group there.
19	CE	Okay. Now, while we're talking about Suburban, we're talking about more
20		down towards the school okay, or did you actually search up where the
22		recovery was made?
23	BR	We never actually our group never actually got up to that area. What we were
24		doing is because it was so wet after Hurricane well it was Tropical
25		Storm Faye. Is that that area was just flooded. And so we were starting at the

2	BR	Negative.
3	CE	Okay. So, knowing what you know today that area that we spent all the time ir
4		recovering the child's remains. You you don't you had no part in any
5		search there?
6	BR	No.
7 8	CE	Okay. Did you see standing water in that area?
9	BR	Yes I did
10	CE	Okay. And do you know what day that was approximately or what dates?
11	BR	Um, I would tell you that we started watching it right after Hurricane Faye,
12		or the Tropical Storm Fay. And we would go down and you know I
13		have a friend that lives Grenade. So, I used to go down there anyway. And
14		I would drive by it just to check to see where the water levels were and how
15		dry it really was. Um, but I would say every two to three weeks we would go
16		down, somebody would check it.
17	CE	And never any luck?
18	BR	Well, no I mean checking meant we were driving down the street to see the
19		conditions. We weren't actually going in to search it. The weekend after
20		Caylee was found was the weekend Richard Creque and I were planning on
22		getting the team together to go into that area. Because we'd finally deemed
23		It dry enough that we could go in. And you guys beat us to the punch.
24	CE	Roy Cronk beat us to the punch.
25	BR	Yeah.

1	CE	Yeah. Okay. Um, you had said you were assisting Texas EquuSearch I
2		believe you had told me.
3	BR	Uh-huh. (affirmative)
4	CE	Ah, possibly in November?
5	BR	Correct.
6	CE	Moving equipment. Can you tell me about that again?
7 8	BR	After Texas EquuSearch called the search ah, they had some equipment
9		That they were gonna leave for people who were gonna work for TES
10		here in Florida. Um, it wasn't an organized thing, but they left some equipment
11		so that we could use it and one of 'em was a laser printer a big one. And
12	;	ah, it was broken but it could be fixed. They asked me to haul it over to some-
13		body's house because it was rather large and I drive a large SUV. And I did
14		that and while I was there I met somebody who ah, I was told was the best
15		friend of Casey Anthony growing up. And
16	CE	Who, Whose house were you at?
17	BR	Um, Gary Greenberg/
18	CE	Okay. And he was with ah, TS…
19 20	BR	He was with TES
21	CE	TES
22	BR	he was a ah
23	CE	(cough) Excuse me.
24	BR	He was with administrative what we call a black shirt. He had one of the
25		black TES shirts.

1	CE	And at his house was this girl?
2	BR	Um, in the garage or the driveway next to his house there were playing.
3		Um, but I don't know if they just cleared out because we were bringing
4		Our stuff in through his driveway and they jut moved to the side. But that's
5		where I met her is kind of in between his condo and the condo next to it.
6 7	CE	What was her name?
8	BR	I believe it was Christina.
9	CE	And you talked to her directly or
10	BR	I talked top her directly.
11	CE	And what did she tell you?
12	BR	I asked her if, if she was really a good friend of Casey's? Where she would
13	she	hangout? Where she thought we should be searching? And the one area that
14	3116	brought up to us was the area where Caylee was ultimately found. Which
15		was that corner right there off Suburban and ah, at the end of the school.
16		forget was it Hope
17	C.	
18	CE	Hope Spring.
19	BR	The other, the other road.
20	SA	Did she say why she would search there?
21	BR	She said that that's where they spent a lot of time as younger kids. That was
22		where they would bury their pets. That's ah, and area that she thought that ah,
23	5	Casey knew very well.
24	CE	Is this the same girl that did the story with I think it was the Globe?
25	BR	I don't know. I don't I'm not familiar with the story of the Globe.

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2	SA	Do you know if she is ah, did she talk to, do you know if she's the same
3		girl that talked to Casey on the phone after Casey was arrested?
4	BR	I, I said I don't know. I mean I know what she looks like from having
5		seen her. But as far as you know the case, I mean I haven't really kept up
6		with every individual
7	SA	Right.
8	BR	Character I guess you would call 'em in the in the case.
9	CE	What was her opinion of the ah, the baby sitter issues?
10	BR	Her opinion was that she was the baby sitter. She told me she goes, you know
11		I took care of Caylee basically. And that her two children were very
12		upset that Caylee was never coming back.
13	SA	Christina had two children?
14	BR	Correct.
15 16	SA	Did Christina ever say she met anybody name Zanny the nanny or Zaneida
17		Gonzales?
18	BR	No she laughed about that, that's what that was all about. She was like, I was
19		the nanny. That's what she told me.
20	SA	Okay.
21	CE	And she, did she stress an opinion regarding what Casey was capable of or
22		if capable of this at all? Or she have any insight in that regard?
23	BR	Um, no she didn't discuss you know what her opinions were on
24		whether Casey had done it or not done it. She just told me she hey if this
25		is the area you're gonna look at. Go take a look at that one.

1	CE	It just strengthened your desire to go back there when it was dry.
2	BR	Correct.
3	CE	Okay.
4	BR	As a matter of fact now I'm thinking about it, it was because of that
5		conversation that I brought up with Richard Creque that that was a key area
6		that we needed to go back to. And we started really checking it for how
7		dry it was. And ah, the, I guess the week that before you guys found
8		Caylee. Richard and I had talked about a couple of areas that we wanted
10		to get some of the TES volunteers who were still willing to search. Um,
11		to go to and one of 'em was Soldier's Creek Park up in I guess near Seminole.
12		And the other one was the Suburban Drive area.
13	CE	Did you ever get to go down there or do that or
14	BR	No, it was just
15	CE	that was just in the planning phases?
16	BR	That was in the planning phase. 'Cause what were doing is we would go up and
17	77 177 177 177 177 177 177 177 177 177	do a search one weekend and then we'd figure out we were going during that
18		week. And then the next weekend we would meet somewhere and then we
19		would go search that.
20	CE	Now would you keep track who was involved in those searches as if it was a
21		EquuSearch thing or
23	BR	Um, Bill Fitzgerald would be the guy you need to talk to.
24	CE BR	Okay. And doe she currently have that paperwork that your aware of?
25	CE	You don't know?

1	BR	The Caylee two search when they, the Texas EquuSearch came back it was ah,
2		out near the airport behind like the ah
4	CE	Industrial Park where they got all the trailers and stuff setup up? That one
5		or
6	BR	Um, no that was the first one.
7	CE	That was the very first one.
8	BR	That was the first search.
9	CE	Okay.
10	BR	That was the one that was off Lee Vista.
11	CE	Right.
12	BR	Now, well the other one too if you kept going down Lee Vista past Semoran
13		and then I think it's on the other side it's called Judge Road. And it goes
14 15		around the corner
16	SA	On the east or west side of 436?
17	BR	Yeah.
18	SA	Okay.
19	CE	So, it wasn't the one where they were at Days Inn? Or the Holiday Inn rather
20		where Brett worked?
21	BR	Um, yeah I was in
22	CE	You were in that one too?
23	BR	I was involved every time that TES came down here except for one. Um,
24		but the two main searches we call Caylee One and the second one is Caylee
25		Two. And I think the second one was in November. And then there was there

2	BR	Yes.
3	CE	Yeah. Um, so, Bill Todd you gave paperwork and where would that paperwork
4		go from there do you have any idea?
5	BR	It would stay there.
6	CE	There.
7	BR	They would take it and put it in a stack and you know of course he
8		would sign it and you know basically let them know what you searched,
9	1	what you didn't search, what you found you know those types of things.
10	CE	Now those, those articles out there that you guys would flag I guess. That's
11	 - -	where they would determine who would get sent back out to check on those
12		things?
13 14	BR	Um, I don't know if they would use those so much to determine who. All
15		it was, was to determine that it did or didn't need to be searched.
16	CE	Needed to be searched again.
17	BR	Correct.
18	CE	Okay. The search, the not one, two, three, but the one that occurred there
19		in the middle ah, at the, at the Days Inn. Where they also did a Kesse
20		Search.
21	BR	Uh-huh. (affirmative)
22	CE	You with me on the weekend? You remember when that was?
23	BR	I'm trying to think.
24	CE	Kind of the unlabeled search.
25	BR	Ah, no because ah, I I don't, I know that they were there through Richard

but yeah I mean Texas EquuSearch would have a lot of people. They were
bringing in people from Texas and they would sit and be the administrative
people. And so, when you got there most people had never seen them before
Unless you were an actual you know longtime member of Texas EquuSearch.
So, I may have met this person, but I wouldn't know by name.

CE Were there primary ah, K-9 handlers that they would have come out and assist you guys? Who.. do you know them by, by names?

Um, the only one I remember is a guy name David and ah, he was the one that had Dixie the pooping cadaver dog. And I actually saw him on another on another search. Ah, Brett Churchill and a couple of the TES people Tony Rovinsky, we ... all went up too North Carolina and did a search for Moy Tang. And ah, this group that David belonged to his group pretty much ran the search up there. And so I saw him up there as well. And I also saw him.. he did come down from South Carolina ah, for the ah, other search the Hailey Cuming search.

- CE Is that where David's from South Carolina?
- BR I believe so. Uh-huh. (affirmative)..
- 20 CE And did you ever see him deploy his.. you never saw any dogs deployed in that area? That you ..
 - BR Not in that area.
- ²³ CE ... recall? Okay. Alright.
- SA That's it.
